We would like to thank our 2018 summer student, Diane Dieujuste, for compiling the results of this year's annual Client Survey. A total of 538 surveys were sent out to clients and 163 were returned for a response rate of 30%.

The satisfaction with our services remains high with the majority of respondents rating the meals and services good and very good. ## **Winter Meal Deliveries**

During the winter season, our dedicated team of Meals on Wheels volunteers make every effort to ensure that services are uninterrupted and our clients receive their meals. In some cases, we may not always be able to reach everyone. Please have non-perishable items on hand in case of emergencies.

Suggested items are:

- Canned goods (fish, fruits, vegetables, soups)
- Snacks such as granola bars, peanut butter, and crackers
- Drinking water
- Dried fruits and nuts
- Dry cereals

Here are some of the key points:

#### Services:

- 100% report that the services in French are "very good" or "good"

- 98% report that our volunteers are friendly
- 98% report that the services "very much" and "somewhat" allow clients to remain in their own homes

- No delivery on January 1<sup>st</sup>. We will be delivering frozen meals on *Wednesday*, January 2<sup>nd</sup> instead.
  Please place your order for this date by 10 a.m. Monday, December 24<sup>th</sup>
- Deliveries will resume a normal schedule as of January 8<sup>th</sup>

#### Friday Deliveries:

- No delivery on December 28th
- Please consider ordering extra meals for delivery on December 21<sup>st</sup> (order by 10 a.m. December 14<sup>th</sup>, as usual)
- Deliveries will resume a normal schedule as of January 4<sup>th</sup>
