COVID-19 Vaccinations



Are you eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine? Please call Ottawa Public Health at 613-691-5505 to book your appointment.

If you have booked your appointment and need transportation assistance:
- If you are a Para Transpo user, you can book your ride to the vaccination clinic through the COVID-19
Vaccination Trip Reservation telephone line at 613-842-3600 between the hours of 10 a.m. and 8 p.m.

 If you are not a Para Transpo user, you can request a ride to and from the clinic through Ottawa Community Transportation at <u>communitysupport.covidresponse.ca</u> <u>/transportationvaccination</u> or by calling 2-1-1.

Are you waiting to hear when you are eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine? Please follow announcements on the City of Ottawa and Ottawa Public Health websites and social media channels and from your local news media to learn when you can receive your vaccine. If you have internet and email access, you can also sign up for an eSubscription through the City of Ottawa on their website which will deliver news straight to your inbox! Preferred Payment Methods

We continue to encourage contactless and more environmentally-friendly options as our preferred methods of payment. Below are a few suggestions to make your account a little "greener":

If you regularly send in a cheque: Save money on postage! By sending in a void cheque once, you can set up automatic payments and simply receive an account statement via mail or email.

If you call every month to pay by credit card: Ask us to set up automatic payments via your credit card.

Numbers are securely stored by our finance team and save our staff time by not needing to re-enter your information each month. You will still receive an account statement via mail or email.

If you use electronic banking, you can send e-transfers: payments can be sent to payments@mealsonwheels-ottawa.org. We are set up for auto-deposit so no password is required.

If you use email, we can switch your paper invoices to digital! We are able to send you your invoices and receipts straight to your inbox. Please call us at 613-233-2424 or email us at service@mealsonwheels-ottawa.org to request e-invoicing. Benefits for e-invoicing include using less paper, receiving your invoices/receipts faster, and having a digital copy to refer back to.
